## DIG DEEPER

1) Have you ever tried to run from your past, and what did you learn when you stopped running?

2) How does the concept of being 'anchored to a future' rather than 'driven by a past' resonate with your own life experiences?

3) Let's read Genesis 27:1-10. What does this reveal about the consequences of deceit, even when it appears to be successful, and how can we guard our hearts from justifying dishonesty for personal gain?

4) What does it mean to you that we serve the 'God of messed up people,' and how does this impact your view of your own worthiness?

5) In Genesis 32:24–32, Jacob wrestles with God and refuses to let go until he receives a blessing. What does this moment teach us about perseverance in our struggles with God, and how have you experienced God shaping you through a personal 'wrestling match' in your own life?

6) Reading Genesis 33:1–11, we see Jacob approach Esau after years of separation and fear, only to be met with unexpected grace and forgiveness. What does their reconciliation reveal about the power and impact of true forgiveness?

7) Based on our conversation today, how might God be calling you to take a step toward reconciliation in your own life?
