- 2) 1 Corinthians 13:5 reminds us that real love isn't selfish or controlling, but marked by humility and compromise. Can you recall a time you set aside your ego for someone you love and by doing so, what was the outcome?
- 3) Romans 12:9 says, "Love must be sincere." If romantic strategies have their limits, what happens when genuine, lasting relationships are built on honesty, trust, and emotional openness?
- 4) Love isn't just a feeling we fall into, it's a commitment we choose to live out every day through patience, sacrifice, and intentionality. Take a moment to reflect: where have you seen this kind of love at work in your relationships?
- 5) Advice rooted in unresolved hurt can lead us down a path shaped by fear instead of wisdom. That's why it's important to consider where advice is coming from. How do you protect yourself from terrible advice?
- 6) Charm may impress for a moment, but character lasts and reveals itself over time. In a culture that often values appearance over integrity, how can you live out the wisdom of Proverbs 31:30 that honors a life marked by faith and godliness?
