- 3) We learned about spiritual confusion and the blending of different beliefs in Cuba. How can we lovingly respond to similar spiritual confusion in our own culture while staying faithful to the gospel?
- 4) At first many experienced a sense of nervousness and felt unprepared to share to share the gospel, yet saw God work through them when they stepped out to faith. Describe a time when God worked through your weakness or fear. What did that experience show you about His power and faithfulness?
- 5) Let's read Matthew 28:18–20. Jesus' final instructions to His followers. What are some reasons Christians might struggle to live this out?
- 6) Several volunteers described feeling deeply passionate and energized in their faith. What does being 'on fire for the Lord' mean to you, and what helps you keep that passion alive over time?
- 7) Filter of Hope emphasizes the need for prayer, giving, going, and advocacy. Which of these areas do you feel most called to engage in, and why?
